

CODE 1: a relatively simple injury/medical condition the responding patroller can handle with just the contents of the Code 1 toboggan. Consider activating EMS if necessary.

Code 2: a more serious injury/medical condition. The responding patroller needs to ask for whatever additional equipment or patrollers needed to assist. Consider activating EMS .

Code 3: a very serious injury/medical condition with the patient's vital signs are declining. Activate EMS and or consideration of a helicopter response.

Code 4: a code 1 or 2, but always code 3 will require an investigation by the supervising paid patrol staff. The Code 4 pack comes with the Code 3 toboggan

Code 5: a patroller needs assistance

Code 6: a guest(s) is/are possible under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Code 7: a Dodge Ridge employee is involved in a injury or has a medical condition. Also call for a Code 1, 2 or 3.

Code 8: Dodge Ridge lifts, towers or other equipment are involved in the injury/medical condition.

Code 9: called when a lift is experience mechanical difficulties. All patrollers should listen for further instructions, but consider getting to the top of the Chair 3 or Chair 7 as quickly as possible or stay at the top of the mountain until the Code 9 is cleared.

Code 10: Lift evacuation is being called.
